It is located on the traditional territory of the Ojibwa people of Fort William First Nation, signatory to the Robinson Superior Treaty of 1850 with many visiting and relocating to the City from remote First Nations Communities. There are also citizens who identify as Metis.

An experienced and respected law enforcement executive, you will motivate and guide a service of over 300 sworn and civilian members.
