

Position: **Police Cadet** February 14, 2025

The Aylmer Police Service announces a selection process for the position of Cadet.

The cadet program is designed to serve as an entry-level position, intended to lead the successful candidate to the role of Police Constable with our service. A cadet is hired on a one-year, full-time contract with a starting salary of \$52,039.39 and an excellent benefit plan. The job description includes assisting citizens with walk-in inquires, record checks, data entry, fingerprinting, summons and subpoena service, assisting with follow up investigations, found property and fleet maintenance. Hours of work will generally be Monday – Friday 0800-1600hrs but may be amended based on operational needs. Interested applicants must meet the following basic criteria;

- Be at least 18 years of age
- Be a Canadian citizen or permanent resident
- Be legally entitled to work in Canada
- Have at least a valid G driver's licence with a good driving record; maximum of six demerit points
- Have successfully completed four years of secondary school education or equivalent
- Be able to meet the physical demands of police duty
- Have been granted or issued a pardon if convicted of a crime under a federal statute
- · Possess current certification in CPR and First Aid

Please note that an OACP Certificate of Results is not required to apply for the cadet position.
